→ **New or persistent symptoms?**

These symptoms don't always mean cancer, but should be checked.

**01** A lump or swelling in part of your testicle

**02** A testicle that gets bigger

**03** A heavy scrotum

**04** Discomfort or pain in your testicle or scrotum

**Most testicular cancer cases are in men aged 15-49.** If you have a family history of testicular cancer, have had it before, and are white British, you have a higher risk.
